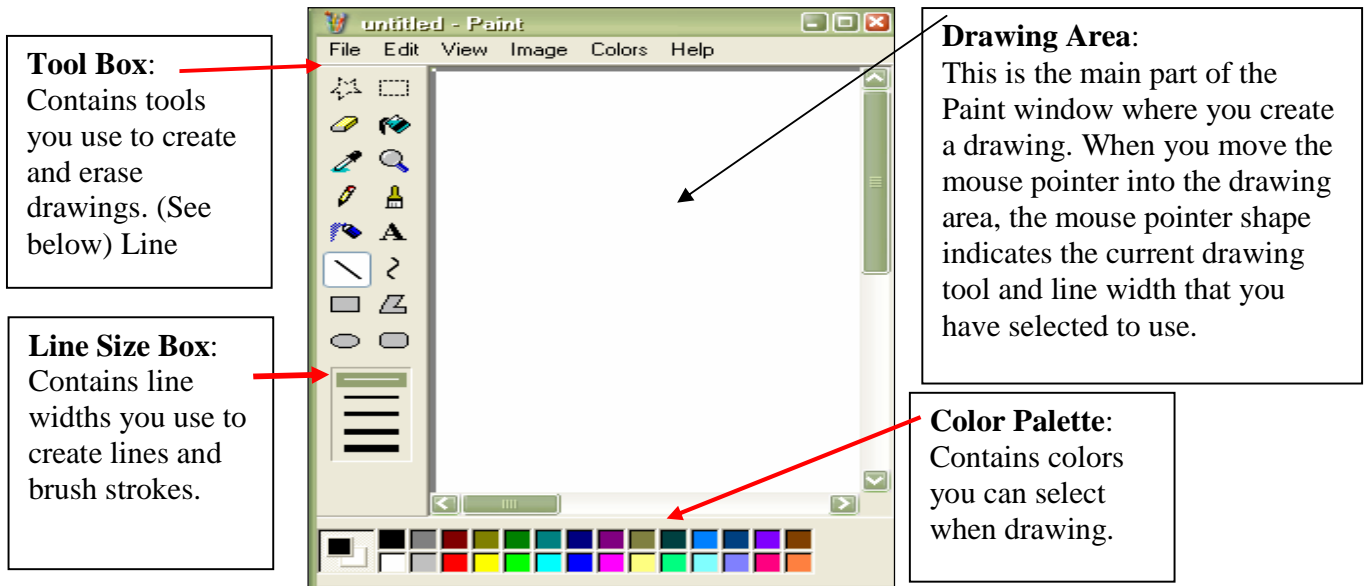


















## HOW TO GET STARTED IN PAINT

Click the **Start** Button, point to **All Programs**, point to **Accessories**, point to **Paint** and click on it.

Paint is an application you use to draw diagrams and charts. You can use Paint to create drawings with lines, rectangles, ellipses, circles and other shapes. You can also apply colors. The Paint window contains the follow components:



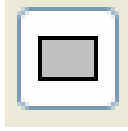
The Paint window uses a toolbox (instead of a toolbar) which consists of 16 different tools that you can use to help you create school projects, assignments at work, or items for your hobbies. Following is a sample of Toolbox items found in Paint. Each toolbox icon is listed along with the individual task it performs.

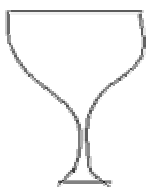
Select the line width
